Guidelines

Thank you for applying for a scholarship through the June Steven's Scholarship Program.

The program aims to support eligible people to overcome barriers and achieve their educational aspirations. Before applying for a scholarship, it is important to understand eligibility criteria. Please read the information below before completing the application form.

- All applications will be assessed against eligibility and assessment criteria.
- You must complete all sections of the application form.
- The primary contact for the application is the person that will benefit from the scholarship, or if you are filling out the form on behalf of someone else, it is the person whose name is on the tenancy agreement with Southern Cross Housing.
- The applicant is the person that will benefit from the scholarship.

To be eligible for a scholarship the recipient must:

- Be a current tenant of Southern Cross Housing living in a Social Housing property that is managed by Southern Cross Housing, (not living in an Affordable Housing) and/or be eligible for Social Housing and receiving support services from at least one of the following organisations within SCH Local Governing Area's (LGA'S):
 - CareSouth
 - The Disability Trust
 - Southern Youth & Family Services
 - Supported Accommodation & Homelessness Services Shoalhaven – Illawarra
 - St Vincent DePaul
 - Uniting Care
 - Waminda
- Have completed and submitted a feedback form (if you have previously received funds under the Scholarship program in any year)
- Submit a completed application form that is accompanied by quotes for all of the proposed purchases of equipment.

The maximum funding levels are:

- Primary School \$400.00
- High School \$800.00
- Tafe/University \$1200.00

- All applications for study at TAFE, University or with a Registered Training organisation must be accompanied by a current enrolment form for the proposed course of study.
- Applicants for Primary and High School study support must be accompanied by a statement of results (school report) for the students most recently completed Year of study applications.
- Maximum of 1 scholarship per applicant per year and 2 per family

Applicants will be advised of outcome of their application mid-January 2024 with funding being awarded shortly after.
