Who are we?

Southern Cross Housing (SCH) is in the top 20 largest Community Housing Providers in Australia with over \$1 billion of assets under management. We are highly regulated under the National Registration System for Community Housing Providers and recognised having Tier 1 status. We are a not-for- profit, Public Benevolent Institution, and registered charity specialising in the provision of social and affordable housing across New South Wales. We have 8 offices and currently over 2,241 properties under management housing over 4,459 residents.

Our core business

The primary objective of SCH's core business is to provide safe, secure, and affordable accommodation for individuals who are unable to secure housing without assistance. The majority of our applicants are selected from the current NSW social housing waitlist, which consists of approximately 57,000 households facing a critical need for housing. This includes 5,300 applicants who are either homeless or at risk of homelessness.

As well as specialising in homelessness support and provision of social housing, SCH also specialises in the provision and management of 'Affordable' housing. Unlike Social housing which is based on 25%-30% of household income, 'Affordable' housing is usually based on 75%-80% of market rent. As well as managing our own 'Affordable' properties, we also manage properties on behalf of private landlords and investors.

As we continue delivering life enhancing social initiatives and outcomes for our clients, SCH is also committed to assisting people purchase their own homes. Owning a home is one of the most rewarding, fulfilling, and self-empowering things people can experience and we are extremely dedicated to helping people move through the continuum of housing tenure to ownership.



Property Management

At SCH, we strive to promote and sustain long-term relationships with our landlords by offering them the security they seek in their investments and the professional services they deserve. We provide capped vacancy assurance and guaranteed rent payments without any additional hidden or monthly charges, which eliminates the risks of negative events such as rental arrears or complex tenancy issues that may arise in the private market. This level of guarantee is not typically offered by typical real estate agencies. Our agreements with landlords, facilitated by Southern Cross Housing, are mutually beneficial to both parties and help increase the availability of affordable homes for our clients in the local community. Our property management portfolio is growing steadily not just because of the benefits we provide to our landlords, but also because many of them see working with us as a way to contribute to the great social benefits we deliver.

Current Projects

Coomea Street, Bomaderry NSW

This modern complex consists of 39 units, offering a mix of 1-, 2-, and 3-bedroom dwellings. Each unit is fully self-contained and includes private open space, with many also featuring convenient parking spaces. The outdoor area offers a communal garden, complete with BBQ facilities and a children's playground. This project is the result of a collaboration between Shoalhaven City Council, the Department of Communities & Justice, and Southern Cross Housing





South Sreet, Ulladulla NSW

Constructed on a site owned by Southern Cross Housing, this exciting project will consist of 26 units designed with ultimate flexibility in mind, with the majority being dual-key apartments

Ulladulla & Cooma NSW

Two projects, each comprising six fully self-contained garden apartments with kitchens, bathrooms, laundries, and private courtyards, have been built on sites owned by Southern Cross Housing. These dwellings are designed for private or controlled access, with communal rooms available for on-site support and management facilities. They are exclusively dedicated to providing safe and secure housing for women and children who are escaping domestic violence.







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
