Opportunity Pathways is an exciting program available to people who receive social housing assistance. The program focusses on offering a flexible and person-centred support to access training, employment and housing independence.

Wesley Mission's Opportunity Pathways team is available across the Illawarra, Shoalhaven, Central Coast, Hunter and Mid North Coast regions.



## Eligibility criteria

Participation in the Opportunity Pathways program is open to people who are:

- 17 years or older
- living in public, community or Aboriginal housing
- receiving a Rent Choice Subsidy; or
- an approved social housing applicant on the NSW Housing Register.

## How does it work?

We will work with participants to develop a Training, Employment and Housing Plan (TEHP) based on their situation, needs and goals.

## What support is available?

Participants will have access to:

- coaching and mentoring
- training and workshops
- work experience placements
- volunteering opportunities
- resume writing assistance
- preparing job applications
- work retention support.

Participants may also receive financial assistance for:

- interview and work clothes
- transport
- childcare and other costs related to employment and training.
